COMING BACK TO CHURCH FOR PRAYER

We welcome you back to Saint Mary Magdalen, beginning Monday, May 11 for morning private prayer from 9-11am. Our online Mass schedule continues via livestream.

We have prepared a place for you – and we want you to know that the health of our parish family, guests, clergy and staff is paramount to us. We are taking every precaution we can to ensure our prayer and liturgy activities follow public health, governmental and diocese recommendations. To achieve that, here's what we ask of you:

Your charity, as we come together as brothers and sisters in Christ, with regard to seating limitations and how we must keep our “social” distance”;

Your prudence, in following the safety practices for coming to church, especially with regard to vulnerable populations who are advised by public health officials to remain at home for their well-being; and

Your patience, with regard to the schedule so we have the proper time to sanitize our facilities;

Private Prayer in the Main Church (chapel, balcony closed)

Monday-Friday: 9am-11am

Saturday: 9am-12noon

Saturday, May 16: Sacrament of Penance - Outside the Chapel

3-4pm in English; 6-7pm in Spanish

Before Coming to Saint Mary Magdalen:

First and foremost, for your own health, and for the love and good of others, let us be reflective of questions such as:

- Am I at a higher-risk or vulnerable with regard to health? The CDC recommends those who are age 65 or older, those with serious underlying conditions such as heart disease, lung disease, auto-immune disorders and diabetes to limit activity outside the home.
 - Have I travelled recently? Have I done a self-check of my temperature? Have I noticed any of the CDC symptoms in the last 48 hours? [CDC Self-check](#)
- Most important, if you are sick in any way, please do not come to church at this time.

How to prepare:

Bring a face covering, such as a mask, scarf, bandana that can fit over your nose and mouth. Face coverings will be needed to enter the church and worn at all times. If you have personal hand sanitizer, we also recommend bringing it with you.

When you arrive:

We are requiring everyone to first go to our check-in station in the church breezeway for a brief review of the screening questions listed above. Face coverings are required to enter the church.

Seating limitations will apply: If we have reached our maximum occupancy, you may have to wait outside or come back at another time. Our grotto area is open for prayer, within similar health and safety guidelines.

Inside the Church:

After check-in, entry only through the main, front church doors. Once inside, go to our Welcome Desk for instruction.

Sanitizing: As you enter the church – and as you exit - everyone is to sanitize their hands.

Seating: Space is limited to adhere to public health guidelines. You will be ushered to the designated seating areas. Members of the same household may sit together.

Time: Our available seating may reach capacity. We ask that you be mindful of others and try to keep your prayer time to no more than 15 minutes.

Exiting the Church:

We ask that as you exit the church you sanitize your hands and return to your car, refraining from congregating in the breezeway or parking lot.

We will continue to work together as a parish family to use this time to grow in our faith. We are always available to pray for you and have many opportunities to strengthen your faith journey, including:
