Eucharistic Adoration

24 HOURS FOR THE LORD

Friday, March 27 at 8 A.M. through Saturday, March 28 at 8 A.M. in the Chapel.

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is a sign of devotion to and worship of Jesus Christ, who is, present among us in his body, blood, soul, and divinity, under the appearance of the consecrated host. He is Immanuel, God with us. We will have a variety of prayer experiences as well as quiet time for personal prayer and adoration over a 24-Hour period. We will provide a prayer guide in the chapel that includes communal and individual prayers.

How can I participate in 24 Hours for the Lord?

The first step is to sign up. The sign up is arranged in half hour increments. Sign up for a half hour, an hour, a couple of hours, or the whole night, depending on your interest and availability. God will use every minute you spend with Him. Scan the QR code or go to <https://www.signupgenius.com/go/24Hours2026#/>.

Can't sign-up? Simply show up! Be present and spend time with the Lord in Eucharistic Adoration.

How do I make a holy hour (or half hour)?

All you need is a tabernacle with a lit sanctuary lamp and YOU. You may wish to bring a Bible, a rosary, headphones to play your favorite meditative music or prayer app, or other spiritual reading.

24 HORAS PARA EL SEÑOR
